3 **A** What's this? It's a birthday card from Dad.

**B** What's this? It's a birthday present from Grandma

**C** What's this? It's a birthday card from Mum

**D** What's this? It's a birthday present from Buster.

#### 4 **Possible answers:.**

**A** The little girl blows out the candles.

**B** The little girl runs to the window / looks out of the window.

**C** Grandma talks on the phone.

**D** The little girl talks on the phone / talks to Grandma.

**E** The little girl looks at the sky / the sun / the sunset.

**F** Grandma lives in the sky.

**G** Grandma flies in her special plane.

These sentences come from the story. If you wish, you could also ask children to make up sentences of their own, which do not come from the story. These can be as fanciful as children like (but must be grammatically correct) e.g.
